Please complete a minimum of one task per half term, but of course you may complete as many of the tasks as you like. You can present your work in any way you wish. We look forward to seeing your work. Have fun!

<b>Talk</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Where do polar bears live? What do they eat? Do all bears live in the same place?</li><li>✓ <b>Talk about what you would measure in centimetres, metres and kilometres. What would you measure in miles?</b></li></ul>
<b>Research</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ What do the following words mean: carnivore, herbivore, omnivore. Can you give examples of each?</li><li>✓ <b>Look in your kitchen cupboards at home. Can you find the weight on the food packets? Write these down! Which is the heaviest and lightest packet of food you have found?</b></li></ul>
<b>Create</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Create a mask of an animal you might find in the jungle.</li><li>✓ <b>Can you create a poster showing counting in twos, fives or tens?</b></li></ul>
<b>Understand</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Look at a map. Can you find the five continents and the oceans?</li><li>✓ What is a healthy diet? Can you create a poster which encourages people to eat lots of fruit and vegetables?</li></ul>
<b>Experiment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Where is the best place to put an ice cube so it does not melt when it comes out of the freezer?</li><li>✓ <b>Measure the height of all the people in your family. Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest? Can you put the heights in order? You can do this using a tape measure, or you can draw round your foot, cut it out and use this to measure how many feet tall your family are.</b></li></ul>
